### **Membership levels:**

- **Full membership** – You are eligible to participate in all club activities - Social and Golf (minimum requirements apply for Club Championship) and will have an active World Handicap System Index. The dues are \$110.
- **Social plus handicap** – You are eligible to attend all social activities of the club plus will have an active World Handicap System Index. You will also be eligible to join SNEWGA through Timberlin with this Membership. The dues are \$45.

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### MEMBERSHIP ACTIVITIES

**RINGERS:** This is your total score for 18 holes, using the best you have scored on each hole throughout the season. The lowest scores are rewarded prizes by flight at the end of the season.

**WEEKLY SWEEPS:** These are our weekly tournaments, called Sweeps. They can be played from Mon. through Sun. You make your own tee time. You can play your Sweeps tournament with other TWGC members or anyone you want to play with as long as you are playing with, and your scorecard is attested by a player who has a World Handicap System Index. Prize money awarded in Pro Shop credit.

**TOURNAMENTS:** Tournaments are predominately 1-day events (only Spring Handicap and Club Championship are 2-day Club Tournaments). Prize money is awarded in Pro Shop credit. This year's Tournaments are AM starts, SAT tournaments, unless indicated otherwise in **BOLD**, as follows:

Opening Day – 4 player Team Blind Draw ABCD Better Ball. 1 <sup>st</sup> Tee Start.	April 27
PYOP (Pick Your Own Partner) Scramble – 2 player teams. Gross & Net. 1 <sup>st</sup> Tee Start.	May 11
Member Guest (fka Memorial) – 4 player teams, minimum 1 guest per team. Better Ball. Gross & Net. 1 <sup>st</sup> Tee Start	May 25
*Spring Handicap – 2 Days. Individual stroke play, Gross & Net. 1st Tee Start on <b>SAT &amp; SUN.</b>	June 8-9
*President's Cup -Individual Stroke Play, Gross & Net. 1 <sup>st</sup> Tee Start ABCD, Better Ball format. 1 <sup>st</sup> Tee Start	June 22 July 13
*Club Championship – 2 Days, Individual stroke play, Gross & Net .1 <sup>st</sup> Tee Start on <b>SAT &amp; SUN.</b>	July 27-July 28
PYOP 6-6-6 – 2 player team Trifecta. Gross & Net. 1 <sup>st</sup> Tee Start.	August 10
*Pro's Trophy – Individual stroke play. Gross & Net. 1 <sup>st</sup> Tee Start.	Sept 7
Member–Member – 2-person Better Ball, Gross & Net. Split Tee Start.	Sept 21
Closing Day – 4 player teams. ABCD, Better Ball, Split Tee Start.	October 12

To play in the Tournaments, you need to contact Cheryl Abraham, Tournament Chair, by end of day on the Saturday before the Tournament date (one-week advanced notice required) via email: [cherylabraham714@yahoo.com](mailto:cherylabraham714@yahoo.com). Tournament Dates will also be listed in the club Member Booklet provided after you join. *NOTE: Tournament prizes will be awarded for 10 of the 11 Tournaments listed above. The exception is the Member Guest (prize money for this event is from a separate entry fee). To participate in the Club Championship, you must have played in at least 4 club events (any Tournament or Sweeps event qualifies, except for Interclub Matches) with at least one being a Tournament. \*Denotes our "Major" Tournaments.*

**SOCIAL ACTIVITIES:** Social gatherings are held at the Club post play. A voucher for \$10 toward lunch is provided to all members who play and/or attend the Opening Day meeting held immediately after Opening Day Play. We also hold a year-end banquet.

**OPTIONAL HOLE-IN-ONE POOL** – Additional \$10 fee (keeps you in the pool until someone scores a hole-in-one and wins the pool)!
