Hello, TWGC members. It is Renewal Time! The 2025 Golf season will be here before you know it, and the Board is excited about our upcoming season! Please complete and return your membership renewal ASAP (to avoid my follow up emails and to allow the Board to plan accordingly)!

Our Opening Day Tournament is scheduled for **Saturday, April 26, 2025**. We will start play in the morning, to be followed by an Opening Day Meeting after conclusion of the Opening Day Tournament.

NOTE: All TWGC Members are invited and encouraged to attend the Opening Day Meeting, even if you cannot join us for golf. Alyssa Scandura (scandura.alyssa@gmail.com) will be issuing an email to all members early/mid-April for those planning to play the Opening Day Tournament and/or will be attending the Opening Day Meeting.

Here is what we have planned for this season.

- Weekly Sweeps (net and net & gross) that can be played from Monday through Sunday. You can play with other members or anyone you want to play with as long as you are playing with, and your scorecard is attested by a player who has a World Handicap System Index.

*Spring Handicap – 2 Days. Individual stroke play, Gross & Net. 1st Tee Start on SAT & SUN .	June 7-8
*President's Cup -Individual Stroke Play, Gross & Net. 1 st Tee Start	June 21
ABCD, Better Ball format. 1 st Tee Start	July 12
*Club Championship – 2 Days, Individual stroke play, Gross & Net .1 st Tee Start on SAT & SUN .	July 26-July 27
PYOP 6-6-6 – 2 player team Trifecta. Gross & Net. 1 st Tee Start.	August 9
*Pro's Trophy – Individual stroke play. Gross & Net. 1 st Tee Start.	Sept 6
Member–Member – 2-person Better Ball, Gross & Net. Split Tee Start.	Sept 20
Closing Day – 4 player teams. ABCD, Better Ball, Split Tee Start.	October 11

- Social gatherings are held at the Club post play. A Lunch Voucher (\$10) will be provided for those attending the Opening Day Tournament and/or Opening Day Meeting. We also hold a year-end banquet.

To participate in the Club Championship, you must have played in at least 4 club events (any Tournament or Sweeps event qualifies, except for Interclub Matches) with at least one being a Tournament.

Membership levels:

- **Full membership** – You are eligible to participate in all club activities (Social and Golf, minimum requirements apply for Club Championship) and will have an active World Handicap System Index. The dues are \$110. **-OR-**
- **Social plus handicap** – You are eligible to attend all social activities of the club plus will have an active World Handicap System Index. You will also be eligible to join SNEWGA through Timberlin with this Membership. The dues are \$45. **-OR-**
- **Honorary membership** -This membership level is for those individuals who were Charter or Long-time members of TWCG and have demonstrated long-term support for the club but are no longer active in club activities. No dues are required.
