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### MEMBERSHIP ACTIVITIES

**RINGERS:** This is your total score for 18 holes, using the best you have scored on each hole throughout the season. The lowest scores are rewarded prizes at the end of the season.

**WEEKLY SWEEPS:** These are our weekly tournaments, called Sweeps. They can be played from Monday through Sunday. You make your own tee time. You can play your Sweeps tournament with other TWGC members or anyone you want to play with as long as you are playing with, and your scorecard is attested by, a player who has a World Handicap System Index. Prize money awarded in Pro Shop credit.

**TOURNAMENTS:** These Tournaments are primarily 1-day (with two 2-day Club Tournaments) held on Saturdays and/or Sundays. Prize money is awarded in Pro Shop credit. This year's Tournaments are AM starts, unless indicated otherwise, as follows:

Opening Day – 4 player Team Blind Draw ABCD Better Ball. 1 <sup>st</sup> Tee Start.	April 29
PYOP (Pick Your Own Partner) Scramble – 2 player teams. Gross & Net. 1 <sup>st</sup> Tee Start.	May 13
Member Guest (fka Memorial) – 4 player teams, minimum 1 guest per team. Team Better Ball. Gross & Net. 1 <sup>st</sup> Tee Start	May 27
*Spring Handicap – 2 Days. Individual stroke play, Gross & Net. 1st Tee Start on Sat & Sun.	June 10-11
*President's Cup -Individual Stroke Play, Gross & Net. 1 <sup>st</sup> Tee Start	June 24
Match Play vs. Hunter – at Hunter (potentially 9:30-10 am Start)	July 2
ABCD, Better Ball format. 1 <sup>st</sup> Tee Start	July 15
*Club Championship – 2 Days, Individual stroke play, Gross & Net .1 <sup>st</sup> Tee Start on Sat & Sun.	July 29-July 30
PYOP 6-6-6 – 2 player team Trifecta. Gross & Net, 1 <sup>st</sup> Tee Start.	August 12
Match Play vs. Rockledge, at Rockledge	TBD
Match Play vs. Stanley – at Timberlin	August 26
*Pro's Trophy – Individual stroke play. Gross & Net. 1 <sup>st</sup> Tee Start.	Sept 9
Member-Member – 2-person Better Ball, Gross & Net. Split Tee Start.	Sept 24 (SUN)
Closing Day – 4 player teams. ABCD, Better Ball, Split Tee Start.	October 14

To play in the Tournaments, you need to contact Diane Hunter, Tournament Chair, by end of day on the Saturday before the Tournament date (one week advanced notice required) via email: dianemariehunter@gmail.com. Tournament dates will also be listed in the club booklet provided after you join. *NOTE: Tournament prizes will be awarded for 10 of the 14 Tournaments listed above. The exceptions are the Member Guest (prize money for this event is from a separate entry fee) and the three Match Play events (vs. Hunter, Rockledge & Stanley). To participate in the Club Championship, you must have played in at least 4 club events (any Tournament or Sweeps event qualifies) with at least one being a Tournament.* \*Denotes our "Major" Tournaments.

**SOCIAL ACTIVITIES:** Social gatherings are held at the Club post play. A voucher for \$10 toward lunch is provided to all members who play and/or attend the Opening Day meeting held immediately after Opening Day Play. We also hold a year-end banquet.

**OPTIONAL HOLE-IN-ONE POOL** – Additional \$10 fee (keeps you in the pool until someone scores a hole-in-one and wins the pool)!

**SNEWGA** is the Southern New England Women's Golf Association. It is based in CT and membership is open to women club members at all public, private and semi-private clubs.
